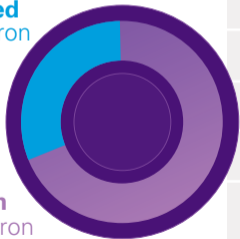


## Federal agencies overwhelming given Chevron Deference

**21% denied Chevron**

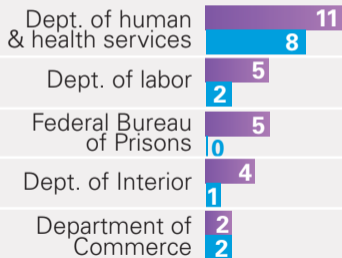
**47% given Chevron**



## Chevron most contested at HHS awarded to agency

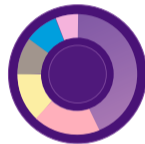
Top contested agency action claims under Chevron

Interested parties filing amicus briefs for Loper Bright & Relentless cases

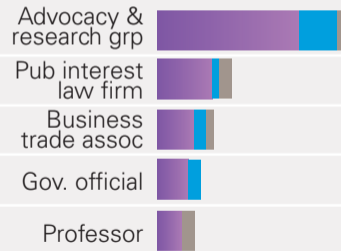
