
Contribution to U.S. trade deficit by country

The U.S. total goods trade deficit currently stands at **-\$1183 billion**.

The U.S. trade gap narrowed to \$61.6 billion in April 2025, (lowest since Sept. 2023) compared to a \$138.3B gap in March. Imports shrunk 16.3 percent to \$351B, after an all-time high of \$419.4B in March.
